Maplesoft Group donates \$1.8M to cancer campaign

The launch of the second phase of an Ottawa campaign to help cancer patients is getting a \$1.8 million boost from a company headquartered in the area, Maplesoft Group president and CEO Jody Campeau announced Tuesday.

The donation from the consulting and business solutions firm will go toward achieving the Ottawa Regional Cancer Foundation's \$50-million target for its Courage Campaign.

"It's important for us to know the money stays here locally," Campeau said after the announcement. "Giving back to the community is something that's ingrained in the fabric of our corporate culture at Maplesoft."

Linda Eagen, president and CEO of the foundation, said the donation will help to achieve their campaign goals: shortening wait times at cancer facilities; developing research and new therapies; bringing care close to home and providing a better quality of life for cancer patients.
