The Ottawa Regional Cancer Foundation, which organizes the Weekend, agreed in 2009 to donate 75 per cent of funds raised by local teams right back to the Hospital's Mammography Campaign.

Last year's Weekend resulted in a donation of \$46,700 for MamCam and our goal this year was to raise at least \$50,000.

This year's participants raised about \$100,000 – and that means that approximately \$75,000 will come right back to KDH, to help local women in their own fight against breast cancer!

We feel that the entire community is behind us and we are making great strides in reaching our goal of \$750,000 to equip the mammography suite.

I want to say thank you to the community members who supported these teams by going to bake sales, yard sales, playing softball in the snow and by sponsoring our many walkers.
