POSITION SUMMARY:

The Cancer System Navigator will join an experienced multi-disciplinary team which responds to requests for support from individuals (i.e., cancer patients, caregivers and those affected by cancer) who approach the Ottawa Cancer Foundation directly, or are referred via medical practitioners or community partners.

They will engage with people affected by cancer to understand their needs, support them in identifying priorities, and connect them to relevant services offered by the Community Cancer Hub and other community partners. The navigators will be equipped to respond to informational, psychological, emotional, spiritual, physical, social, and practical needs and provide follow-up support when requested.

The Cancer System Navigator also helps to identify gaps, and participates in system change opportunities to offer recommendations for programs and services to meet the needs of individuals affected by cancer in the region.

CANDIDATE PROFILE:

Education:

Master's degree in a registered healthcare profession (nursing, social work, or equivalent in human sciences) and a minimum of 3 years in related employment OR undergraduate degree in a registered healthcare profession (nursing, social work, or equivalent in human sciences) with a minimum of 7 years' experience in related employment.

<u>Professional Affiliation:</u> Registration with accrediting body of aforementioned healthcare profession required.

Experience and knowledge:

- Experience with assessing patients' wellness and support needs, helping individuals self-identify needs and connecting them with services that can help address those needs required
- Appropriate minimum professional experience (stated above) with individuals who have a significant emotional or physical health issue required
- Experience with case notes/file recording required

- Demonstrated experience working within a supportive care model providing patient/client focused care an asset
- Experience in or knowledge of oncology care an asset
- Experience facilitating workshops and group sessions an asset
- Ability to support clients in-person, or via phone or video conferencing as requested
- Demonstrated ability to work collaboratively across multidisciplinary teams
- Demonstrated understanding and experience with implementing health equity strategies an asset
